Incorrect deduction of TDS from my monthly pension of July 2021.

This has reference to AIUBRF letter No.151/2021 dated 31st July 2021 addressed to Chief General Manager (HR) on my concerns of deduction of TDS from pension of July 2021.

I am surprised to find that an amount of Rs..... has been deducted towards TDS from my Pension on 31.7.2021 without any proper notice or information to me, or affording any opportunity to me to respond.

- a) In terms of CBDT directions, my Pension is less than Rs.5.5 lakhs,
OR (*strike out whichever is not applicable)
- b) I have already submitted my investment declaration to the Pension paying branch/online on

and I am entitled to rebate under sec 87A as a Senior Citizen; hence no deduction of TDS is deductible by the Bank.

Kindly therefore refund the amount of TDs deducted immediately, as the same is unwarranted and *ultravires* of the Income Tax Act in force. I shall be compelled to seek recourse to claim compensation & interest on the amount deducted if not refunded.
